You can meet a person for cooperation thanks to:

- Going to conferences networking : backstage talks, meals, etc.,
- Making contact by email, Research Gate etc. (request for publications, advice, etc.),
- Invitation to Poland to deliver a seminar / lecture,
- Invitation to the conference to the program committee, to deliver a lecture (invited presentation),
- Invitation to write a joint work, grant,
- Request for reviews (doctorate, conference work, journal, etc.).

How to take care of relationships ?:

- better, contacts on a private level, but one should remember about cultural differences,
- Systematic contacts (e-mail, announcements, social media, etc.),
- Timeliness in the implementation of assigned tasks (writing articles, reviews).



Grants supporting cooperation:

- Grants of the Polish National Agency for Academic Exchange,
- NCN Polonez a competition for scientists coming from abroad,
- NCN Symfonia competition for cross- domain research
- NCN Miniatura initial research, pilot research, query, research internship, conference trip, research trip or consultation trip may be financed,
- Bilateral programs between Poland and another country,
- International foundations (eg the Kościuszko Foundation, the Fullbright program).



Conference Organization:

- Organizing a scientific conference is an opportunity to establish contacts with many teams / people, including the possibility of inviting conferences to TPC, invitations to deliver a plenary lecture (keynote lecture), etc.,
- The decision to organize an edition of a conference in a given location is usually made by the conference steering committee comittee. The organization of a conference requires a lot of organizational work,
- Less work is related to the organization of a special session (special session) or workshops (workshop) as part of a larger conference, because organizational matters (venue, meals, etc.) are organized as part of the main conference



Cooperation with the industry

Establishing contact with the company:

- Personal contact (word of mouth, prior acquaintance),
- Participation in conferences / fairs to look for partners,
- Announcing your own offer, e.g. http://biznes.pwr.edu.pl/,

Finding funds for research / cooperation :

- NCBiR,
- Mozart program (Wrocław Academic Center),
- Some companies announce their grant competitions,
- A new company, e.g. spinoff, startup.
