## General OHS training course

### Who is it for?

OHS training courses are obligatory for all freshman students with the exception of those who have already completed an OHS online training course in the course of their studies at Wrocław University of Science and Technology.

OHS online training courses are provided through the e-learning platform at ePortal.



This course is provided in three modules:

- Occupational Health and Safety
- Fire protection
- First Aid

You must study the training course materials and receive **the minimum score of 70% in each of the module tests** to successfully complete this training course.

## How do I prepare?

### 1. Find out about your training course schedule

- Type <http://ohs-training.pwr.edu.pl>
- Find your training course schedule for your faculty.
- You must study training course materials and take the module tests to successfully complete the training course.

### 2. Log in to Wrocław University of Science and Technology ePortal

- Log in to <http://eportal.pwr.edu.pl> (available from the 1st day of the semester) using the same username and password that you use for your account in JSOS.
- You will receive all necessary information on the platform that will help you choose the correct course. Have fun!

### 3. Get your OHS certificate

- After completing the course, **you will need to create your certificate** in the system and save it or print it out. The certificate will be registered in the JSOS system.
